Do you know the law?

- Providing alcohol to a minor or providing a place for minors to drink is a Class A misdemeanor.
- That includes any land, building, structure or room you own, lease, rent or procure.
- Failing to abide by the law can result in a minimum \$1,000 fine, as well as one year in jail.
- You can be charged with operating an open saloon if your guests pay for alcohol.

Don't invite trouble. Never provide alcohol to a minor or condone or host drinking parties.
